

Directions to Help Care for Your New Puppy

For the first day, you should put out small amounts of food and water to make sure your puppy is eating and drinking and if it isn't, contact us immediately.

A puppy needs rest. They are like any baby and need their quiet rest time as well as their play time.

Sometimes if a puppy does not get its food, water, and rest, it may go into hyperglycemia, known as sugar shock. If this happens, it may seem lethargic or could even have a seizure. Just by giving them a little honey or nutri-cal, a vitamin dietary supplement, you can usually bring them out of this. However, if this does happen, you should call us immediately no matter what time it is. If you can't get in contact with us, you should always go to a vet if your puppy has a problem.

Sometimes, just the stress from leaving their siblings and their other puppy friends can cause them to develop diarrhea. This is caused by coccidia or giardia. If your puppy develops this, please contact us. We have the medications to take care of these problems. Again, if you can't reach me, go to your vet.

It seems to me that puppies are just like any baby. They may get sick very fast, but if treated quickly and properly they will recover quickly.
